


About VR Health Champions


Who Can Apply?


- **SMEs** from the following regions:

 - Upper-Bavaria (Germany)
 - Lisbon (Portugal)

Applicants must be able to demonstrate at least 1 year of business or professional activity









Categories of regions

Less developed regions (GDP/head (PPS) less than 75% of the EU-27 average)


Fransition regions (GDP/head (PPS) between 75% and 100% of the EU-27 average)

More developed regions (GDP/head (PPS) above 100% of the EU-27 average)
